“Stabilizing Argentina is ‘America First,’” a Treasury Department spokesman said. “A strong, stable Argentina helps anchor a prosperous Western Hemisphere, which is explicitly in the strategic interest of the United States.”



Capuano says he met with his executive leadership team in Bethesda, Md., where they decided to take a week to research and process before meeting again. The CEO then flew to Los Angeles for the Americas Lodging Investment Summit. While there, he was inundated with questions about Marriott's approach to DEI in the future.

Rather than stay silent, Capuano recalled many conversations with his mentor and former chairman Bill Marriott, and decided to speak.

"The winds blow, but there are some fundamental truths for those 98 years," Capuano said. "We welcome all to our hotels and we create opportunities for all—and fundamentally those will never change. The words might change, but that's who we are as a company."

“We welcome a genuine, constructive conversation with diverse ideas and perspectives about food and agriculture production. [But] this is not a real dialogue. It is a staged event, a mock trial where anti-agriculture technology and anti-Monsanto critics play organisers, judge and jury, and where the outcome is pre-determined,” wrote Martha Burmaster, Monsanto’s director of human rights.

The Monsanto statement added: “We help farmers mitigate and adapt to climate change. Our products and services help farmers to use data science to grow food in a more sustainable and carbon-neutral way. We have made commitments and taken actions to enhance honey-bee health; create a healthy ecosystem for monarch butterflies; and help rural communities preserve their forest-farmland ecosystem, prevent illegal deforestation and protect local species.

“We believe in the coexistence of all types of farming practices, and in farmers’ individual freedom to choose the production method that makes most sense for their goals - be it growing crops using conventional methods or with genetically-modified seeds and other modern techniques, or by following organic practices”.

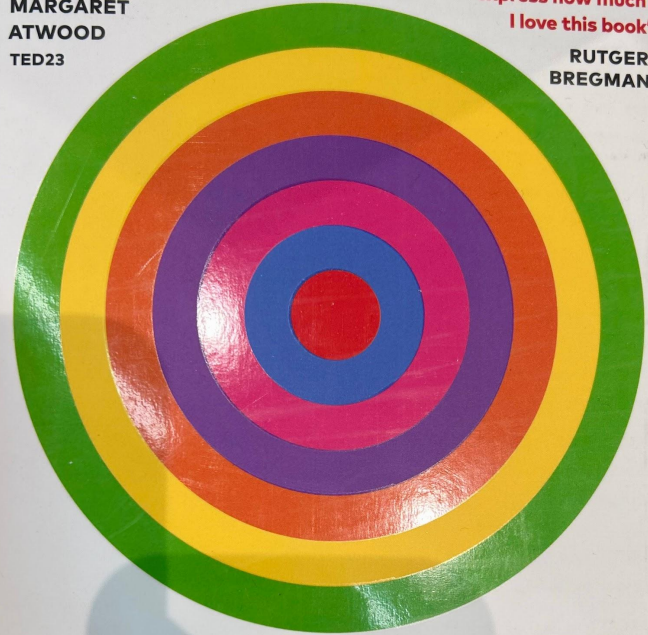
