Don Lemon, Founder of Lemon Media Network and Host of the Don Lemon Show

Don Lemon spent thirty years as a trusted voice on CNN, NBC, and MSNBC before leaving to build his own media company. Today he independently produces and hosts The Don Lemon Show across YouTube, podcast platforms, and social, and has grown Lemon Media Network to more than 10

million followers across platforms with no outside investors and a business funded entirely by its audience and partners.

At CNN he anchored Don Lemon Tonight for more than eight years, co-anchored CNN This Morning, moderated presidential town halls, co-moderated the first 2020 Democratic presidential debate, and led the network's coverage of George Floyd's death and the protests that followed. His on-the-scene reporting spans Ferguson, Uvalde, Charleston, Pulse, Sandy Hook, Ukraine, and the death of Queen Elizabeth II.

He is a New York Times bestselling author of *This Is the Fire* and *I Once Was Lost: My Search for God in America*, and his work has been recognized with an Edward R. Murrow Award and three Emmys. He is one of the most prominent Black gay journalists in American media.
