Megan Whittemore, Chief of Staff to the U.S. Ambassador to China

Megan Whittemore serves as Chief of Staff to the U.S. Ambassador to China, where she leads strategic coordination with the White House, NSC, State, Defense, Commerce, and Treasury in America's most consequential bilateral relationship.

Her career spans the full arc of policy, politics, and media: she began as a producer at Fox News Channel, served as national spokesperson for House Majority Leader Eric Cantor, and was Chief of Staff to U.S. Senator David Perdue on the Senate Foreign Relations, Armed Services, Banking, and Budget Committees.

In the private sector, she led global external affairs for Corning Incorporated, repositioning the Fortune 300 company's narrative as the infrastructure backbone of America's AI future, and served as a Managing Director at Penta Group advising multinational corporations on geopolitical risk and reputational challenges.

Megan is a graduate of The George Washington University where she has been an Adjunct Professor. She is a lifetime member of the Council on Foreign Relations and former president of the bipartisan Senate Press Secretaries Association.
